- Terminal Care Planning

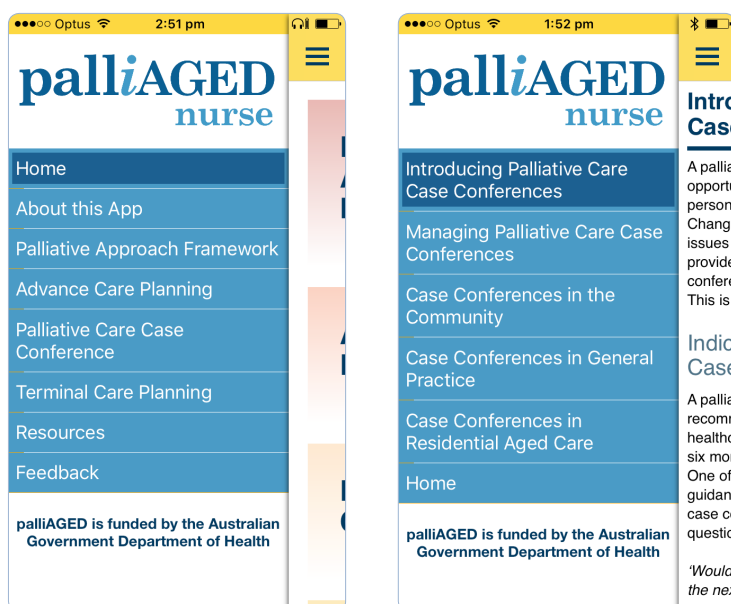
What makes
